2.6 Right to Termination

The TIA may terminate the bid process at any time and without assigning any reason. The TIA makes no commitments, expressed or implied that this process will result in a business transaction with anyone. This tender document does not constitute an offer by the TIA. The bidder's participation in this process may result in the TIA selecting the bidder to engage towards execution of the contract. In the event of such termination, EMD of all bidders shall be returned, without any interest.

3. Bid Submission Instructions

3.1 Bid Submission

- a) The bidder shall submit the bid in Hard copy to office address on or before due date.
- b) The bids submitted, shall comprise of the following 2 envelopes:

 - **Envelope A:** Technical Bid
 - **Envelope B:** Financial Bid



- c) Modification and Withdrawal of Bids - Resubmission of bid by the bidders for any number of times before the final date and time of submission is allowed.

3.2 Eligibility Criteria

The Bidder shall fulfil all of the following eligibility criteria independently, as on the date of submission of bid

1	Bidder must have a minimum average turnover of Rs. One Fifty Lakhs (Rs.150,00,000/-) during three financial years (FY 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24) OR (FY 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25)
2	Bidder should be registered under VAT during financial year 2016-17 must submit VAT clearance
3	Bidder should be registered under GST & should submit GST clearance
4	Bidder should be submit Bank solvency RS. 5,00,000/- lakh of nationalised bank.
5	Bidder should have at least 3 years relevant work experience
6	Bidder should submit ISO 9001 registration
7	Bidder should have its main office / branch office anywhere in Maharashtra.
8	Bidder should provide appropriate Registration.
9	Bidder has not been found guilty and has not been blacklisted or debarred by any State Government or Central Government Department/ Union Territory/ Local Authority/ Central and State Government Undertaking or Government Organizations as on the date of submission of bid.

3.3 Technical Bid (Envelop - A): Documents to be uploaded

The Technical bid must be submitted as per the instructions and in this tender document. Following documents are mandatory and should be submitted in Hard copy.

3.4 Financial Bid (Envelop - B)

- Financial/price offer must be submitted in BOQ format.
- Quoted price shall be inclusive of raw material, labour, designing, etc. in excluding GST



3.6 Corrections / errors in Financial Bid

1. The bidders are advised to exercise adequate care in quoting the prices. No excuse for corrections in the quoted figures will be entertained after the last date for submission of bids.
2. The quoted price shall be corrected for arithmetical errors by TIA.

3.7 Language

The bid should be submitted by the bidder in English language only. If any supporting documents submitted are in any language other than English, translation of the same in English language is to be duly attested by the bidders. For purposes of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall govern. If any documentary evidence for 'Experience' is in other languages, a true translation of the copy, attested by Notary shall be enclosed.

3.8 Conditions under which Tender is issued

- A. This tender document is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. The TIA reserves the right to withdraw the tender document and change or vary any part thereof, at any stage. The TIA reserves the right to disqualify any bidder, should it be so necessary at any stage.
- B. The timing and sequence of events resulting from this tender document shall ultimately be determined by the TIA.
- C. No verbal conversations or agreements with any official, agent, or employee of the TIA shall affect or modify any terms of this tender document and any alleged verbal agreement or arrangement made by a bidder with any agency, official or employee of the TIA shall be superseded by the definitive agreement that results from this tender process. Verbal communications by the TIA to bidder shall not be considered binding on it, nor shall any written materials provided by any person other than the TIA.
- D. Neither the bidder nor any of the bidder's representatives shall have any claims whatsoever against the TIA or any of their respective officials, agents, or employees arising out of or relating to this tender document or these procedures (other than those arising under a definitive service agreement with the bidder in accordance with the terms thereof).

3.9 Right to the content of Bids-

All bids and accompanying documentation of the technical bids will become the property of the TIA and will not be returned after opening of the



Technical bids. The IA is not restricted in its rights; to use or disclose any or all of the information contained in the bid and can do so without compensation to the bidder. The TIA shall also not be bound by any language in the bid indicating the confidentiality of the bid, or any other restriction on its use or disclosure.

3.10 Non-Conforming Bid

A bid may be construed as a non-conforming bid and ineligible for consideration if:

1. It does not comply with the requirements of this tender document.
2. It does not follow the format requested in this tender document or does not appear to address the requirements as specified by the TIA.

3.11 Disqualification

The bid is liable to be disqualified in the following cases or in case the bidder fails to meet the requirements as indicated in this tender document:

1. The bid is not submitted in accordance with the procedure and formats prescribed in this document or treated as non-conforming bid.
2. During the validity of the bid, or its extended period, if any, the bidder increases the quoted prices.
3. The bidder qualifies the bid with own conditions.
4. The bid is submitted in an incomplete form and not quoted for all the items/services.
5. The information submitted in the Technical bid is found to be misrepresented, incorrect or false, accidentally, unwittingly or otherwise, at any time during the processing of the Contract (no matter at what stage) or during the tenure of the Contract including the extension period, if any.
6. The Financial bid is enclosed with the Technical bid.
7. The bidder tries to influence the bid evaluation process by unlawful/corrupt/fraudulent means at any point of time during the tender process.
8. In case anyone bidder submits multiple bids or if common interests are found in two or more bidder, the bidder are likely to be disqualified.
9. Any form of canvassing / lobbying / influence / query regarding short listing etc. will be treated as disqualification. While evaluating the bids, if it comes to the TIA's knowledge expressly or implied, that some bidder may have colluded in any manner whatsoever or otherwise joined to form an alliance resulting in delaying the processing of bid, then the bidder so involved are liable to be



disqualified for this Contract as well as for a further period of four years from participation in any of the tenders floated by the TIA.

10. If the Technical bids contains any information on price, pricing policy, pricing mechanism or any information indicative of the financial aspects of the bid.

3.12 Acknowledgement of Understanding

By submitting the bid, each bidder shall be deemed to acknowledge that bidder has carefully read all sections of this tender document, including all forms, schedules, annexure, corrigendum and addendums (if any) hereto, and has fully informed itself as to all existing conditions and limitations.

1. Bid opening and Evaluation process

4.1 Bid Opening

Bids are opened on the date and time specified in the tender notice.

4.2 Opening of Envelop - A (Technical Bid)

Envelope No. A (Technical bid) of the bidder will be opened through-tendering procedure.

4.3 Evaluation of Technical Bid

The evaluation of the technical bids will be carried out in the following manner:

- 1 The bidder' technical bid will be evaluated as per the requirements and evaluation criteria as spelt out in Section 3.2 of this tender document. The bidders required to submit all required documentation in support of the criteria specified as per the formats specified in this tender document.
- 2 In any case, in the event of any deviation from the factual information provided by the bidder in technical bid, the deviation can reject the bid and also ban the bidder from participation in any future tenders in the state of Maharashtra.
- 3 At any time during the bid evaluation process, the SGVS committee may seek verbal / written clarifications from the bidder. The committee may seek inputs from their professional experts in the evaluation process.
- 4 The committee reserves the right to do a reference check of the past experience stated by the bidder. Any feedback received during the reference check shall be taken into account during the technical evaluation process.
- 5 The technically shortlisted bidder will be informed date and venue of the opening of the financial bids by SGVS.

4.4 Opening of Envelop - B (Financial Bid)

This envelope of technically qualified bidders shall be opened as per tendering procedure after opening of Envelope No. A (Technical bid). The date and time of opening of financial bids will be published on website <http://www.sadbhavanagvs.org.in>

4.5 Award Criteria



a) Evaluation of Financial bids **will be done for all the packages together i.e. total amount quoted by the bidder.**

The TIA shall award the contract to the bidder whose offer/quote has been determined to be the lowest evaluated bid as mentioned above and is substantially responsive to the bidding documents. TIA may negotiate with the L1 bidder and finalise the rate.

b) The TIA reserves the right to issue 50% supply order to the L1 bidder if the L-1 bidder is from out of Maharashtra State and 50% order will be issued to the next lowest bidder who is ready to match L1 rate if said bidder is within the State of Maharashtra. But if no any bidder from Maharashtra state ready to match L1 rate in such case 100% supply order will be issued to L1 bidder.

4.6 Right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all Bids

The TIA reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the tendering process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for the TIA's action.

4.7 Notification of Award

- a. Before expiry of the bid validity period, the TIA will notify the successful bidder in writing, by registered / speed post or by fax or by email that its bid has been accepted by the Tender Inviting Authority.
- b. The successful bidder, upon receipt of the acceptance letter, shall furnish the required performance security in the form of Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft and submit an agreement in the prescribed format within ten days, failing which the EMD will be forfeited and the award will be cancelled
- c. After cancellation of award of contract with L1 bidder (after forfeiting EMD/ Performance security) , TIA reserves the right to call L2 (during bid validity period) and asked to match the rate offered by L1. If L2 accept the offer, award of contract will be issued to L2. If L2 refuse to match rate with L1, then L3 will ask to match rate with L1 and if L3 accepts award of contract will be issued to L3 and so on. In such case EMD submitted by L2, L3...will not be forfeited if they refuse to match the rate with L1.
- d. The Notification of Award shall constitute the formation of the Contract.

4.8 Contract

Acceptance of work order by successful bidder constitute binding contract between TIA and successful bidder. If the successful bidder fails to give acceptance to work order within the specified period or failed to deposit Performance Security within the time specified period or withdraws the tender; the Earnest Money Deposit of the successful bidder shall stand forfeited and will also be liable for blacklist for participating in any tender published by any government organisation.

4.9 Failure to agree with Terms and Conditions of this Tender



Failure of the successful bidder to agree with the terms & conditions of the tender document shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award, resulting which the TIA may call for new bids and at the same time, invoke the performance Security of the successful bidder.

4.10 Performance Security

The selected bidder shall deposit the Performance Security as follows:

- a. The successful bidder shall at his own expense, deposit with the TIA, a Performance Security in the form of Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft as mentioned in clause 1.2.
- b. The Performance Security may be discharged/returned by the TIA upon being satisfied that there has been due performance of the obligations of the successful bidder under the contract. However, no interest shall be payable on the Performance Security
- c. The TIA shall also be entitled to make recoveries from the Performance Security on the following grounds:
 1. Termination of contract /cancellation of work order due to failure of bidder.
 2. Any amount imposed as a fine for irregularities Committed by the bidder.
 3. Any amount which the TIA becomes liable to the Government /Third party on behalf of any default of the bidder or any of his/her/their agent/ employees or staff.
 4. Any payment/fine made under the order/judgment of any court/consumer forum or law enforcing agency or any person working on his behalf.
 5. Any other outstanding amount.

4.12 Liquidity damages: -

Any delay by the successful bidder in the work shall render the supplier/vender liable to be charged liquidated damages @ 1 % per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of work order value which will be deducted from the payment due. If the value of the liquidated damages exceeds 10%, in such case TIA may terminate the contract without any liability on TIA.

4.13 Payment Terms

Payment will be made within three weeks after receipt/submission of following documents

Scope of Work:

A comprehensive scope of work (SOW) ensures contractors provide accurate bids and minimizes future dispute risks. Here is a structured template defining the vendor scope for a stream desilting, deepening and widening project.

1. Pre-Construction & Surveying

- **Site Survey:** Verify existing stream dimensions, cross-sections, and longitudinal slopes before starting.
- **Boundary Marking:** Stake out the exact widening limits and construction buffer zones clearly.
- **Utilities Identification:** Locate and safeguard underground pipes, cables, or overhead lines near the stream.
- **Drone/Photo Logging:** Capture high-resolution pre-construction video and photo documentation of the entire stretch.

2. Site Preparation & Mobilisation

- **Equipment Deployment:** Mobilise heavy machinery including hydraulic excavators, tippers, dumper trucks, and dewatering pumps.
- **Temporary Access:** Construct stable approach roads and ramps for machinery entry without damaging adjacent properties.
- **Vegetation Clearing:** Remove wild shrubs, weeds, debris, and plastic waste blocking the stream bed and banks.

3. Core Execution Works

- **Desilting & Dredging:** Excavate accumulated silt, sludge, and hard compacted deposits down to the natural bed level.
- **Stream Widening:** Excavate stream banks to approved design widths, ensuring a uniform cross-section to optimize water retention.
- **Slope Stabilization:** Grade and compact the stream banks to a safe angle (e.g., 1:1.5 or 1:2) to prevent future soil collapse.
- **Water Channelization:** Implement temporary diversions or coffer dams to manage active water flow during excavation.

4. Silt Management & Disposal

- **Drying & Segregation:** Deposit wet silt in designated on-site drying beds to drain excess water.



- **Waste Haulage:** Transport excavated silt and non-hazardous waste away from the site using covered dumper trucks.
- **Disposal Compliance:** Dump materials only at government-approved municipal or low-lying disposal sites.

5. Water Conservation & Allied Structures

- **Silt Traps:** Construct rock or wire-crane silt traps at entry points to catch future sediment.
- **Recharge Structures:** Create small earthen bunds or loose boulder check dams along the bed to slow velocity and boost groundwater recharge.
- **Erosion Control:** Install stone pitching, gabion walls, or geo-textile mats at sharp bends and high-velocity zones.

6. Safety, Environment, & Quality Control

- **Public Safety:** Install barricades, caution tape, and night-lit warning signage around deep excavation zones.
- **Daily Clean-up:** Keep public roads free of spilled mud or slush during transit.
- **Post-Work Survey:** Conduct a joint final survey with the project engineer to verify completed depths, widths, and slopes against the design plan.
